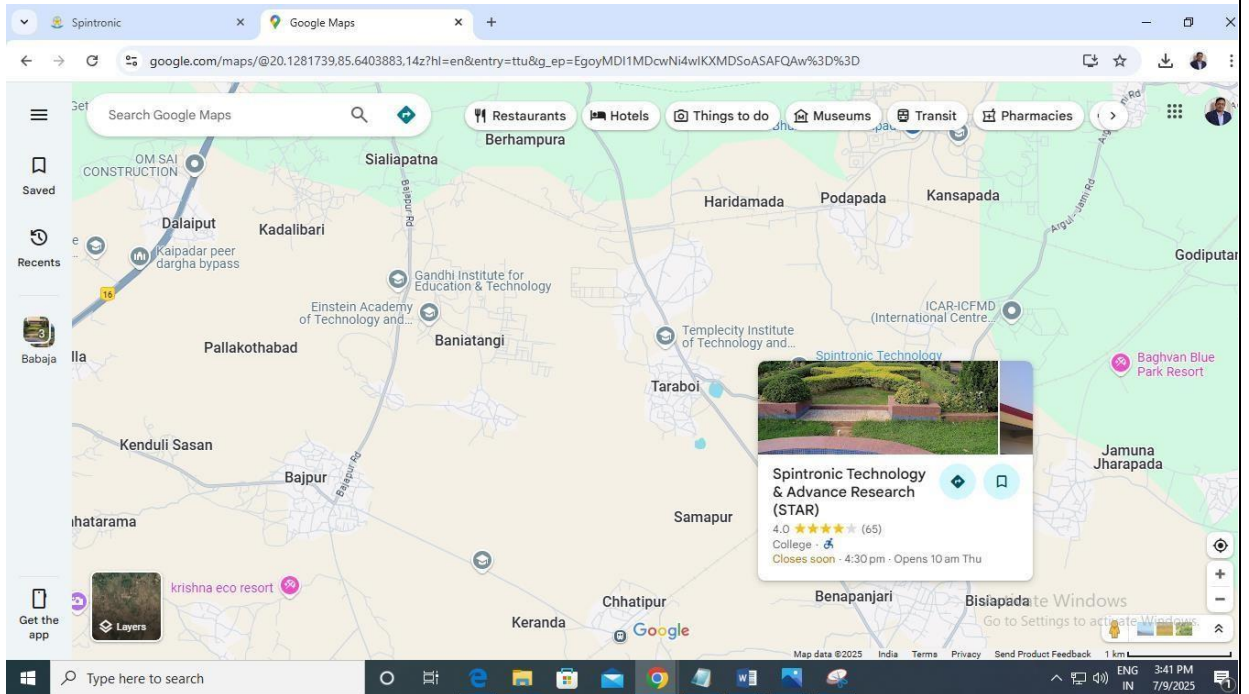

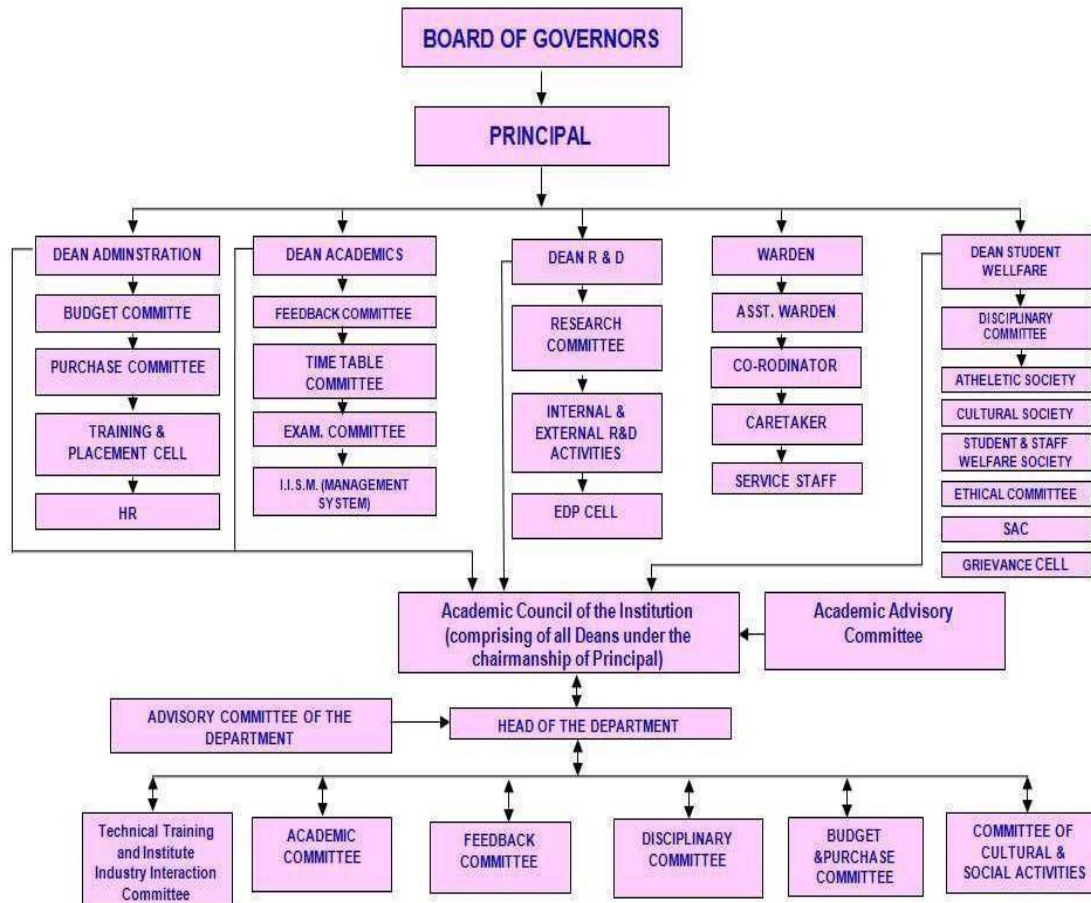

at the work place. The ICC has a responsibility to establish an effective internal complaints procedure, where:

- Assurance that no victimization will result from making a complaint.
- Procedure is well documented, available and in accessible formats.
- Members who manage complaints are well trained.
- Assistance is provided in the form of language interpreters as needed for parties to a complaint.
- Ensuring the process is confidential, independent and based on principles of natural justice.
- Ensuring the process has clear timelines.
- All conflicts of interest are managed appropriately.

On receipt of a complaint, the ICC shall conduct preliminary enquiry so as to ascertain the truth of the allegations by collecting the documentary evidence as well as recording statements of any possible witnesses including the complainant. The ICC shall then submit the preliminary enquiry report to Convenor/Disciplinary authority along with all the original documents adduced during the preliminary enquiry proceedings. In case the allegations are not in the nature of sexual harassment, the ICC may refer such complaints to the Grievance Redressal Cell or to Registrar.

Where sexual harassment occurs as a result of an act, ICC shall take all steps necessary and reasonable to assist the affected person in terms of support and preventive action.

The ICC shall comply with the procedure prescribed in the aforementioned UGC Regulations 2015 and the Sexual Harassment Act for inquiring into the complaint in a time bound manner.

If the ICC concludes that the allegations made were false, malicious or the complaint was made knowing it is to be untrue or forged or misleading information has been provided during the enquiry, the complainant shall be liable to be punished as per the relevant provision of the aforementioned UGC Regulations 2015.
